An electric pallet truck raises and lowers the pallets through the push of a button and is normally self-propelled. Being used generally in situations where the pallets are really heavy, this model would need regular time to recharge. These electric pallet trucks can move backward and frontward at various rates of speed. Various models require that an operator walks alongside the equipment, while other units have a compartment for the user to ride in a standing position.

There are lift pallet trucks which are suitable for using round shelves that are up to 1.5 meters, or up to 5 feet tall. These types of pallet trucks can raise the pallet above the standard 10 inches or 25.5 cm. They likewise come in both manual and electric models.

All kinds of pallet jack whether non-powered or powered would be rated for specific load weights. Lifting heavier pallets than the equipment are rated for can result in risk for the operator, result in damage to the user and materials and can void the guarantee on the equipment. If there is a chance you could be transporting freight which is normally heavier than two thousand pounds or nine hundred seven kilograms, considering the need for a forklift or even a heavy duty truck can be a safer and more reliable alternative. Picking the very best pallet truck to meet your requirements means recognizing the quality of other units. For occasional lifting of light stuff, a low-cost model may be sufficient.
